Seeking Consultant for Strategic Plan Development

Request for Proposals

The SDP IWG invites tenders from consultancy companies or individuals to develop a Strategic Plan for the SDP IWG. This will involve conducting a study to firmly establish the concept and strategy, as well as proposing a meaningful working structure for the merging of the SDP IWG with the UN Office on Sport for Development and Peace (UNOSDP).

The project will be undertaken in close cooperation with the SDP IWG Secretariat, and is scheduled to be concluded by 1 February 2014. The attached document contains a detailed description and complete schedule for the project.
